# News from St John's and St Mary's

The evening with author Hazel Prior and her harp here in church on 12<sup>th</sup> July raised £362.00 for the church's finances. In the coming week we welcome the Somerset Youth Orchestra and Somerset Youth Concert Band to St John's. **On Tuesday at 7.30 p.m.** St John's Church will be the setting for a concert by the **Somerset County Youth Orchestra** under their conductor, Andrew Sherwood.

The programme will include the premier of 'Galactic Procession', music composed by the Milverton Primary School pupil Elliot Coles. In another first for the orchestra, conductor Andrew Sherwood will pass the baton to Louis Bennyworth, a senior orchestra member. Louis' debut as conductor will see him directing a performance of Max Bruch's popular 'Violin Concerto No. 1' in which Andrew Sherwood, a violin professor, will be the soloist. The evening will also include 'Pluto's Song', written by Wellington composer Julian Breeze.

On Wednesday at 7.00 p.m. the Somerset Youth Concert Band will perform a wide-ranging mixture of pieces in varying musical styles – a programme to suit every taste!

Admission prices are the same for each concert, £11 and Concessions for Students & Under 16s at £9. They are bookable in advance although there will be admission at the door.

On Saturday 27th St Mary's Church, West Buckland, is providing Cream Teas from 3-5 p.m. The church's cream teas are much sought after and the envy of many, so for a pleasant afternoon do go over to West Buckland to one the most glorious surroundings and one of the most beautiful buildings in Somerset. Profits go towards the various projects needed to maintain the church.

Looking ahead, St John's and St Mary's churches are combing to produce a **Harvest Festival** weekend to remember!

On Saturday 14<sup>th</sup> September at 7 p.m. in West Buckland Village Hall, there will be a two-course harvest supper with a fully licensed bar and the opportunity to join in a Barn Dance with music provide by The Widdershins. Tickets limited to sixty and priced at £12 each will be available from early August. All are invited including people of the wider communities.
