### Electoral Roll – Important!

The Church Representation Rules require that every Parochial Church Council maintains an electoral roll. Electoral Rolls need to be revised annually. Once in every six years, the preparation of new church electoral rolls takes place, which means that every annual must some off the roll and re apply. The port escasion

which means that everyone must come off the roll and re-apply. The next occasion for the preparation of new rolls is in 2025.

Therefore, notice is given that under the Church Representation Rules, a new Church Electoral Roll is being prepared. Every person who wishes to have his or her name entered on the new Roll, whether it is entered on the present Roll or not, is requested to apply for enrolment. There are forms at the back of the church for you to complete. Please fill these in and return either to Sharon in the office or to our Electoral Roll Officer, Maralyn Norman. The deadline for these forms to be received is <u>Sunday, 6<sup>th</sup> April, 2025</u>. Many thanks.
